

CRO 2 ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSE FOR STAFF OFFICERS

I. Type of the course

CRO 2 is a specialist course designed for staff which is planned for participation in multinational peacekeeping operations and functioning in multinational staffs (UN, EU, NATO, PfP). The program includes vocabulary and structures typical for NATO operational procedures. The course provides participants with the opportunity to practice and improve all language skills (speaking, listening, reading and writing). A special emphasis is placed on communication skills fostered through individual, pair and group work.

II. Duration

The course lasts 2 weeks i.e. 10 working days. Students have 6 classes with the course facilitators and instructors and two classes in the Self-Access Center each day. That makes 60+20 classes in total.

III. Certification

Participants will be issued certificates of attendance provided that they have attended 90% of classes and have given in-class briefings and the final presentation that will be evaluated by the course facilitators.

IV. Requirements

Participants should have a score of at least 80% on the ALCPT/ELC or STANAG 2222 in order to be able to participate actively in the theoretical component of study as well as course projects.

Participants should attach the copy of their language knowledge certificate to their application form. The ALCPT result is valid within the last six months, and STANAG within a year.
